

**The Relief Work Report headed by KUCTE, Kumarapuram  
during the flood occurred in August 2018**

Under the leadership of teaching faculties, all the staffs and teacher trainees of KUCTE, Kumarapuram have handed over the essential materials and food items of Rs.32500/- at S.M.V. School Collection Centre on 17/08/2018.



Sreehari K.G., one of our student from Sanskrit optional participated in food distribution and house cleaning as part of the rescue operation took place at Paravur & Aluva at 18/08/2018 and continued till 23<sup>rd</sup> August. Around 14 students ensured their services as volunteers at various collection centres in different sections from 17/08/2018 to 19/08/2018.



Kadambari G.S. from Natural Science optional continued her service till 29<sup>th</sup> August. According to the recommendation of the District Collector about the urgent need of baby food and edible food on 18<sup>th</sup> August, the representatives from teaching staff and students were handed over flattened rice, jaggery and baby foods at Thiruvananthapuram Corporation. They are also registered as volunteers and participated in the activities on 19/08/2018.





As part of voluntary work, we have covered Kowdiar area and were informed to the houses and shops that the Thiruvananthapuram Corporation will be working as a Collection Centre and the necessary supplies could be given directly there. In addition to that a Cheque of Rs.12550/- were handed over to the CM's Relief Fund. Apart from all these services, all the faculties from KUCTE, Kumarapuaram contributed their 6 days salary to the CM's Relief Fund.
