The Kerala University College of Teacher Education at Thiruvananthapuram was started in the campus of Govt. Girls High School, Barton Hill on 9th October 1990. The new temple of knowledge was inaugurated by Sri.K.Chandrasekharan Nair, Hon'ble Minister of Education. At the beginning, the strength of the College was 307. There were nine faculty members including the Director Dr.R.Sukumaran Nair. He was succeeded by Dr.K.Sukumaran and then by Dr.J.Gowrikutty Amma. Prof.C.K.Lily served as Director of the institution and then as Principal, Smt.Beena.O served as Principal-in-Charge, Prof.K.Jacob Mathew served as Principal and Dr.M.Vijayakumari Amma took charge as Principal and continuing till date. The K U C T E Kumrapuram is one of the pioneering Teacher Education Colleges of the University of Kerala.
